In recent years, tourism development has been governed by the goals and principles of the Tourism Master Plan 2008-18, which was updated in 2012."

Paraguay is a relatively unknown entity when it comes to global tourism, something that is reflected in its comparatively low international arrivals figures – UNWTO data for 2011 and 2012 rank it as the tenth most visited South American country (out of 13) – and the small contribution that tourism currently makes to the economy. Recording 570,000 international tourist visitors in 2012 (UNWTO), Paraguay lags behind the region's big players. UNWTO data also show that Brazil, for example, received almost 5.7 million tourists and Argentina almost 5.6 million in the same year.
