Changes will now focus on the entire lighting system in buildings, an area where there remains considerable consumer misconception and lack of understanding."

This report looks at the following areas:

Demand for lighting equipment is dependent on end user demand, primarily from individuals, the construction sector and the automotive industry. Additional demand is also derived from specialised market sectors, such as the arts and the theatre.

Demand for light bulbs and lamps is driven by the replacement sector, which is less exposed to cyclical economic fluctuations and therefore provides an element of stability to the market. Nonetheless, MBD believes the market is highly price sensitive, reflecting the continued price erosion of domestic lamps as cheaper exports and own brand labels remain a feature of this commodity market. Price is the main competitive issue in the lighting industry, particularly in the more mature areas of the lamps market. The light fittings sector is more exposed to economic variables, such as disposable income and construction output. Demand in this sector is also influenced by expenditure on security, which often incorporates lighting as a crime deterrent or as part of infrared monitoring.

Competition in the lighting sector for different types of equipment largely reflects trends, fashions and technological innovations, not least the continued development towards low energy products. This, in turn, is influenced by a combination of factors, including legislative requirements, environmental factors and design trends.
