The UK has the third largest medical equipment market in Europe, behind Germany and France. In 2018, it had an estimated value of £4.6 billion. The majority of healthcare is provided by the NHS, which is free at the point of use for all residents of the UK. The private sector accounts for a relatively small proportion of total healthcare provision, though it has seen a fairly substantial rise in NHS contracts over recent times.
